

**2005/2006 RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS FOR
1ST LEVEL GRADUATES (BSc) AND 2ND LEVEL GRADUATES (MSc)**

The "Consorzio per lo Sviluppo Internazionale dell'Università di Trieste" (Consortium for International Development of the University of Trieste) has allocated for the year 2005/2006 two fellowships of € 10.000,00 each for 1st and 2nd level graduates from Albania, Belarus, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Macedonia, Moldavia, Poland, Romania, Russia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Ukraine, Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro).

Art. 1

The fellowships will be granted to carry out research projects at the University of Trieste. Applicants must hold a first level degree (BSc or equivalent) or a second level degree (MSc or equivalent) and must be under 35 years of age. Proficiency in English and/or Italian is required.

Art. 2

The Fellowships are for a twelve months period of full-time work, starting from December 1st 2005, or, if later, from the first day of work at the University of Trieste.

Art. 3

The grants will be paid in three instalments:

€ 5.000,00 (tax included) upon arrival
€ 4.000,00 (tax included) after six months
€ 1.000,00 (tax included) at the end of the research work, upon submission of the final report by a Professor of the University of Trieste, who will act as the scientific responsible of the project.

Taxes will not be deducted from the grant if there is an agreement on taxation between Italy and the home country of the fellow.

In this case, the fellow shall produce the following documents:

- a) a certificate issued by the relevant foreign Authority stating his/her personal data (date of birth and place of residence);
- b) a certificate issued by the relevant foreign Authority stating his/her foreign Taxpayer Code;
- c) a statement issued by the foreign Tax Authority, drawn, or legally translated, in Italian or English, certifying the payment of taxes in his/her country of residence, with reference to the application of the International

Agreement against double taxation on income and assets between his/her country of residence and the Republic of Italy

- d) a statement by the fellow to avail himself/herself of the above – mentioned Agreement as implemented in the national legislation of his/her Country of residence; the pertinent law and paragraph(s) must be specified.

Should the above-listed documents not be produced, the “Conorzio” shall be entitled by law to apply tax deduction as a due tax.

Art. 4

Upon notification of the fellowship award the fellow will be required to underwrite a health insurance in Italy for the whole duration of the fellowship. The cost of the insurance is not covered by the fellowship.

Art. 5

The fellow will submit every four months to the "Conorzio" a progress report co-signed by the supervisor.

Upon completing the project, the fellow must submit to the "Conorzio" a final report, co-signed by the supervisor of the project, summarizing the research work carried out and the results achieved. The “Conorzio per lo Sviluppo Internazionale dell’Università di Trieste” must be acknowledged in any publication arising from this work.

Art. 6

Applications on the appropriate form (enclosed) must be received by the “Conorzio” **NOT LATER THAN OCTOBER 15TH 2005**, at the following address:

The following documents must be enclosed in the application:

- a first/second level degree (or equivalent) certificate including all exams and marks obtained;
- a curriculum vitae;
- a declaration of proficiency in English and/or Italian;
- a list of publications, if applicable;
- an outline of the research project that the candidate intends to carry out under the supervision of a staff member of the University of Trieste;
- a letter of acceptance of the proposed programme from the supervisor.

Art. 7

The evaluation of the applications and the final decision will be entrusted to a "ad hoc" Committee appointed by the Administrative Board of the "Consorzio". The Committee will be chaired by the President of the "Consorzio" or by his Deputy.

Art. 8

The application for the fellowship implies acceptance of the above regulations and the commitment to inform the "Consorzio" on the starting date of the full time research activity within 60 days from notification of the award.

Art. 9

Granting of the scholarship shall depend on the approval of financial funds by the relevant Authority of Friuli Venezia Giulia.
